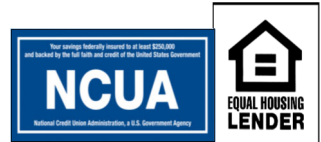

Apple Dumplings

Medium Granny Smith Apples (about 2 Cups)

2 cans 8 oz each Pillsbury Crescent rolls

3/4 cup melted butter

1 cup packed brown sugar

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

2/3 cup Sprite from 20 oz bottle

Heat oven to 350 F. Spray 13x9 inch pan with cooking spray. Peel and core apples; cut into 16 slices. Unroll dough; separate into 16 triangles. Place one apple slice on the shortest side of each dough triangle. Starting with the shortest side of the triangle, roll to opposite point, wrapping dough around the apple slice; arrange in pan. Stir together the melted butter, brown sugar and cinnamon. Pour evenly over dumplings. Pour soft drink in center and along the edges of pan. **Do not pour on top of dumplings.** Bake 33 to 36 minutes or until golden brown. Let stand 15 minutes.

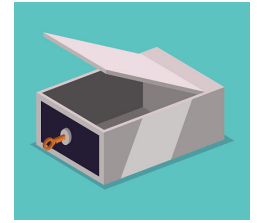
Security Spotlight

With transaction fraud on the rise, we recommend a few tips you should follow. **Know what to look for.** Be aware of skimmers used at ATM machines and gas pumps. Skimmers are small electronic devices that fit over the slot where your card would be inserted. You can gently pull on the area to see if it moves or comes away. If this happens, it may be a skimming device. **Look for hidden Cameras.** Criminals use pinhole size cameras to get your information. It's best to cover the keypad with your hand when entering your pin number. **Check the keypad itself.** Check for anything that seems out of place or unusual. **Know your surroundings.** Busy machines are the ones most likely to be targeted by criminals. Make sure you are in view of security cameras and you have sufficient lighting in the area. If you don't feel safe, you should leave.
